Services for US Department of Defense- The Training Keys staff has led many of the DoD data science training and literacy programs resulting in the first Data Science curriculum at the National Cryptologic School and NSA's Data Science Literacy Initiative to train its workforce. They have also managed the Mathematics, Cryptanalysis, and Data Science curricula there. Other training includes six different instructional escape rooms in the areas of Signals Mathematics, Cryptanalysis, Data Science, Cybersecurity, and Knowledge Management. All of these products and services are still in use today and are modeled by other agencies.

STEM Enrichment Programs- Dr. Nelson has offered a number of enrichment programs motivating awareness and interest in STEM. She has offered interactive math camps on cryptology and secret codes to middle school girls at events hosted by the Every Girl Can Learning Institute and Delta Sigma Theta Inc. on cryptography, cryptanalysis, and steganography. Another math camp presented transposition ciphers, secrets of Pascal's triangle, and a data science introduction. She also coached the Mississippi Cyber Initiative (MCI) staff in the making and execution of its first all-day Cyber Protectors Camp on cybersecurity for high school students concluding with an instructional escape room competition.

Wellness Training- Training Keys personnel have facilitated several wellness training events for wellness groups and the general public. The leadership team consists of subject matter experts in Reiki, holistic medicine, martial arts, reflexology, massage therapy, and other healing modalities. The one-day "Inner View Conference" offered provided self- assessments, holistic healing techniques, and stress management strategies. The "Weekly Wellness Workshop" series presented interactive 1-hour seminars held both in-person and online. Staff members have also presented workshops to the University of Maryland Baltimore County Wellness Community on Reiki and the science of color therapy, and many other topics in the natural healing space have been presented by request.

*Prince George's County, MD Community Public Awareness Council-* Dr. Nelson created and implemented a five-unit curriculum for the Prince George's County Community Public Awareness Council's (CPAC) Meeting of the Minds serving at-risk youth that has been used since 2011. Five units covering Responsible Citizenship, Academic Achievement, Professional Development, Conflict Resolution, and Personal Wellness incorporate hands-on activities, take-home projects, and group discussions that provide basic life skills necessary to be successful. The artifacts produced by the students from this instruction are used to assess their readiness to graduate from the program.

Instructional Escape Rooms- The Training Keys staff has custom-made over 20 escape rooms that have been delivered in a range of formats and can be brought to customer sites for convenience. These activities have been delivered in the classroom, through online platforms, at conferences, in the office, and even at homes. As an option, customers can include a follow-up analysis of the demonstrated team dynamics to highlight their strengths and challenges and identify ways to improve team outcomes. Training Keys has facilitated escape rooms for many organizations, including University of Maryland Baltimore County, Department of Defense, E Cyber7 Technologies, Mercy Health, Online Learning Consortium, Tapia Diversity in Computing Conference, and others.
